

Community Paediatric Endocrinology, Windsor, Ontario

We are looking to recruit a paediatric endocrinologist to work in Windsor, Ontario. This is a fee-for-service, community position with the opportunity to liaise and work collaboratively with the academic paediatric endocrinology group at Children's Hospital, London Health Sciences Center. The clinical volume in Windsor and Southwestern Ontario is expanding and we see the need to have specialized endocrinology and diabetes care in Windsor. Teaching, research, and CME opportunities exist in Windsor in collaboration with the Division of Paediatric Endocrinology and the distributed Schulich medical education enterprise in Windsor. Depending on the qualifications and academic goals of the candidate, an adjunct or full clinical appointment with the Schulich School of Medicine, Western University would be considered.

The Department of Pediatrics is located at Windsor Regional Hospital with an active inpatient and outpatient unit as well as an NICU and Family Birthing Unit with around 4000 deliveries a year. There are 10 pediatricians who share coverage of the inpatient Clinical Teaching Unit, a multidisciplinary service with medical students, Family Medicine Residents, Pediatric Residents, Social Work, Dietician, Pediatric Pharmacist, Child Life and Nursing Staff. We have about 230 pediatric diabetes patients who are followed at our multidisciplinary pediatric diabetes clinic.

In 1993 the Children's Hospital, London Health Sciences Centre established a pediatric endocrine outreach clinic in Windsor. This outreach clinic has expanded to meet patient needs and developed as a Satellite Growth Centre. The local clinic team includes paediatric nurses with endocrine expertise, a dietitian and social worker. Stimulation testing can be done through this clinic. The clinic population includes patients with CAH, thyroid conditions, growth hormone deficiency, pituitary and adrenal problems, pubertal problems and other endocrine conditions.

Windsor is a vibrant, multicultural community located across the river from Detroit which offers proximity to professional sports and theatre and an international airport within less than an hour drive. We also have an excellent variety of restaurants, Caesar's Hotel and Casino and park land that extends along a large portion of the riverfront.
